Now that you understand some history of the FUN show, suffice to say we were really busy and we heard many other dealers reported having a great show. Almost no one but Cat predicted it. We not only sold a lot of great coins, but the buying was over the top. We have piled up some really nice coins and purchased some larger groups that we are sorting through to see what will make the list. We did sell our 1796 half in F15, but have acquired a really attractive VG08 to replace it. We also have a very nice VG10 1796 quarter coming online next week. Unfortunately with shipping the coins home and unwinding from such a busy show, many of our new coins will only be making the list by the end of this week and some next week. We were able to post about 40-50 new offerings up to this point, so certainly don't wait to view our list, but keep in mind that within one week, we will have twice as many nupes. Danny has promised to provide a listing of coming soon and if you see something you might like we can reserve *First Shot* for you. We truly expect to have one of our strongest inventories ever as we go into ANA this summer. Expect the list to grow over the next 4 weeks. It's going to be big, really big!

Speaking of the ANA, please check our schedule for this show, which is actually two shows.
